HEABC and Health Science Professionals Bargaining Association reach tentative agreement

After almost nine months of bargaining, the employer bargaining team, led by HEABC, and the Health Science Professionals Bargaining Association (HSPBA) reached a tentative agreement under the Province's Shared Recovery Mandate on Wednesday, November 2, 2022.

Negotiations under the Shared Recovery Mandate support government's key priorities to improve public services and the health care system, while supporting the province's continued economic recovery for all. Details of the agreement will be available in the coming weeks as the ratification processes for both union members and employers unfold.

About the HSPBA

Led by the Health Sciences Association of BC, which represents approximately 81 percent of HSPBA's almost 22,000 members, the Health Science Professionals Sector Collective Agreement covers a diverse group of health science professionals who provide services in acute, rehabilitation, community, and long-term care settings.

The current Health Services & Support Facilities Subsector Association Collective Agreement expired on March 31, 2022. However, the terms and conditions of the current collective agreement remain in effect until the parties ratify a new collective agreement.

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
