## Nominations open for 2018 BC Health Care Awards Event recognizes outstanding achievements in health care delivery across the province

VANCOUVER – Nominations are now open for the 12th annual *BC Health Care Awards*. The awards celebrate successes and achievements in BC's health care system, and recognize people and teams who provide outstanding care and support. Awards are for projects that improve health care delivery, and for individuals who make a positive impact and inspire those around them.

Nominations are accepted online at <u>BCHealthCareAwards.ca</u> until March 16, 2018. Health care colleagues and members of the public – including patients and their families – have the opportunity to recognize and thank health care employees in their communities by submitting a nomination.

"The BC Health Care Awards are a great opportunity to highlight some of the incredible health care professionals who ensure that British Columbians receive world-class, person-centred health care services each and every day," said Health Minister Adrian Dix. "Over the past 11 years, the awards have recognized more than 210 individuals and project teams who have made our province a leader in patient care, medical research and innovation."

Dianna Mah-Jones, an occupational therapist at GF Strong Rehabilitation Centre, was named Provincial Health Care Hero at the 2017 awards gala. Mah-Jones was tragically killed, along with her husband Richard Jones, just three months after receiving the award. This year, a new award has been named in her honour – the Dianna Mah-Jones Award of Excellence in Person-Centred Care. The award recognizes teams or projects that make use of leading practices to improve care for patients, residents or clients by focusing on the needs of the person rather than the needs of the system or service. Successful nominations will show how health care providers partner with patients, clients or residents to co-design and deliver health care that is respectful of the needs, values and preferences of individuals.
