WHO CAN NOMINATE?

Anyone, including patients, colleagues, managers or members of the public. Review the online *How to Submit a Winning Nomination* guide for detailed information. Be thorough, but concise, and give specific examples of how the award criteria have been met, and health care practices or care have improved as a result.

THE CATEGORIES

Top Innovation

A project or best practice by one of BC's publicly funded health care employers that demonstrates innovative solutions.

Workplace Health Innovation

A project or best practice that makes use of leading practices and innovative thinking to improve workplace health and safety.

Collaborative Solutions

A joint project or best practice that harnesses the collective efforts of a team within the health system to generate positive outcomes.

Dianna Mah-Jones Award of Excellence in Person-Centred Care

A team or project that demonstrates leadership in person-centred by focusing on the needs of the person rather than the needs of the system or service.

Health Care Hero (es)

Characterized by the heart they put into their work, Health Care Heroes inspire those around them and make a difference by going above and beyond.

Oustanding Health Care Volunteer

A role model for dedication, compassion and community service supporting a public or non-profit health care organization, or undertaken a variety of volunteer activities in one year.
